

Waiver Reimagine FAQs

DTH to Day Support & Prevocational Services Transitions

Q - Can people who received DTH services prior to 2021 continue to receive Prevocational Services without time limits?

A – Yes.

Q - Can Day Support and Prevocational Services be provided in the same building/space?

A – Yes. Both services may be provided in the same location.

Q - Can we start using Prevocational Service 15 minute units for everyone?

A – Yes, Prevocational Services are now available for center-based work on all four disability waivers.

Q - When moving people from DT&H services (that want to work in facility), should we use Prevocational Services on the 6790M?

A – Yes, this is the appropriate service code.

Q - I thought daily rates would not be available in 2021, why do I see it as an option on the 6790M?

A – While it is true that Day Support Services (DSS) is only available in 15-minute units, Prevocational Services can still be authorized as a daily (6 hour) rate.

Q – Earlier, I heard that people receiving Prevocational Services were required to also receive another day or employment service (i.e., Day Support or Employment Exploration). Is this still true.

A – No. DHS recommends authorizing other services as a best practice, but it is not required.

Q – Are Prevocational Services required before beginning Employment Services?

A – No.

Waiver Reimagine Project

Q - When will the next report to the legislature regarding the Waiver Reimagine Project be released?

A - DHS has communicated that the next Waiver Reimagine Legislative Report will be released by mid-February 2021.

Q - When the four waivers are consolidated to two, are day services in the individual or residential waiver?

A – Day & Employment Services will be available under both waivers.
